We the People

Article I
Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.
Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in that State.
Section 3. The Senate shall be composed of two Senators from each State, chosen by the Legislature thereof, for a Term of Years, and each Senator shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in that State.
Section 4. The Times, Places and Manner of holding the Elections of Senators and Representatives, shall be prescribed in each State by the Legislature thereof; but the Congress may at any time by Law alter or change these Rules.
Section 5. The Congress shall assemble at least once in every Year, and such Meeting shall begin at Noon on the first Monday in October, and shall continue until they adjourn.
Section 6. The Congress shall have Power to lay and collect Taxes, Duties, Imposts and Excises, to regulate Commerce with foreign Nations, among the several States, and with the Indian Tribes; to borrow Money on the Credit of the United States, to emit Money, and to fix the Standard of Weights and Measures; to define and punish Offences against the Law of Nations, and Offences against the Law of the United States, and Crimes committed on the high Seas, or in any Vessel upon the Sea; to define and punish the Piracy and Offences against the Law of Nations; to declare War, to authorize Letters of Marque and Reprisal, and to grant Letters of Marque and Reprisal; to raise and support Armies, but no Appropriation of Money shall be for a longer Term than two Years; to organize, arm, and discipline the Militia, and to govern the Rules and Regulations of the Militia when called into actual Service; to provide and maintain a Navy, and to organize and discipline the Navy; to make and enforce Laws, unless otherwise provided in this Constitution, respecting the Territory or other Property belonging to the United States; to exercise exclusive Legislation over all Districts ceded to the United States by other States, and over any Place purchased by the Consent of the Legislature of the State in which such Place shall be situated; to exercise all the Powers herein granted to the Congress of the United States.
